

# WELLINGTON AIRPORT SETS COURSE FOR NET-ZERO EMISSIONS BY 2030

Wellington Airport has launched an ambitious plan to reach net zero emissions by 2030.

Air travel is vital to Wellington and New Zealand, so it has to change and become more sustainable.

Key steps in our plan include:

- Reducing overall energy use by making our buildings more efficient
- Replacing our gas boilers and moving to 100% renewable energy sources
- Replacing our vehicle fleet with electric vehicles
- Offsetting staff travel and any remaining emissions

We're also working with airlines to help them adopt new technologies and fuels to lower their own emissions. Our aim is to be a hub for electric regional flights which should be in regular service by the end of the decade.

While there is a lot more to do, we are proud of the progress we're making. In October last year we were ranked 3rd in the world for sustainability amongst participating airports, following an independent global assessment.

### **ELECTRIFYING OUR GROUND FLEET**

We're excited to have welcomed three brand-new electric vehicles into Wellington Airport's ground fleet recently.

We like to name our vehicles, so following a staff competition we've settled on "Van No-Diesel". "Led Zappelin" and "AC/EV"!

So far we've converted a third of our vehicle fleet to electric as part of our long-term decarbonisation journey. Each of these vehicles is reducing our carbon emissions by two and a half tonnes each per year, as well as being much cheaper to run.

And if you are parking an e-vehicle at the airport, remember we have dedicated parking and free charging in the multi-level car park.

Locky docks have been used over a million times around the world over the last five years, without a single theft!

## AIRPORT FIRE SERVICE OUT IN THE COMMUNITY

We have a team of 23 firefighters at Wellington Airport who are often out and about in the community.

In recent months they've attended the Kilbirnie Christmas Parade, Life Flight Trust open day, and the Emergency Services Expo.

Our Panther fire trucks are always a big hit. Each vehicle holds 9500 litres of water and 1500 litres of foam which can be blasted out in under two minutes.
