We are thrilled to announce that the Cystic Fibrosis Christmas Tree Festival will once again be held at Wellington International Airport. We welcome you to join other leading businesses to sponsor and decorate a tree for display at the airport.

The festival is held throughout December and over the New Year period. Thousands of travellers pass through the airport every day and the festival provides high-visibility advertising space for your business.

2018 marks 50 years of Cystic Fibrosis NZ, and 50 years of supporting people with cystic fibrosis. This year we are aiming to have 50 trees on display – a huge challenge and an exciting opportunity for the charity.

Last year we had 25 businesses with trees on display, raising a record total of \$40,000. Your sponsorship means that we can continue to offer social worker support, provide essential medical equipment, and fund research and advocacy efforts.

How does it work?

We provide the tree and you provide the decorations – use your company logo and get creative. Your imagination is the limit!

Decorations should reflect your business – the Christmas Tree Festival provides high-visibility advertising in a premium advertising space.

When is the festival?

Trees will be installed during the last week of November and taken down in the first week of January 2019. Final dates will be confirmed soon.

What does it cost?

You will be invoiced for the sponsorship package you choose.

Different packages are available depending on the size of your tree and how prominently it will be displayed. Packages will range in price from \$500 to \$3,000.

What's in it for me?

The festival provides an excellent opportunity to get your brand infront of up to 20,000 potential customers each day, In addition to this, the first place winner will be awarded a \$5,000 advertising package at Wellington Airport.

What else is there?

You will be invited to the opening gala – a great opportunity to meet with people from like-minded businesses.

Security issues

The festival is at an international airport making security issues very important.

Although any decorations are fine, you should be aware that airport security will inspect each tree after installation. In particular they will look for any decorations that could potentially be hiding something, for example boxes or parcels.

Once inspected they may be stickered to show they are safe. Airport operations and security personnel will have the final say on tree placement.
